The Alaska Industrial Development and Export Authority (AIDEA) and the Alaska Energy Authority (AEA) are hosting this Open House to share information about progress on the Interior Energy Project, and to provide the opportunity for people to meet key players.

The project was introduced by Governor Parnell in 2013, with the goal to bring low cost natural gas to as many Interior Alaskans as possible – as soon as possible. The Legislature approved a bill that provides the financial tools needed to liquefy natural gas on the North Slope for trucking to the Interior. Financing to help develop natural gas distribution systems in Fairbanks and North Pole is also part of the project.

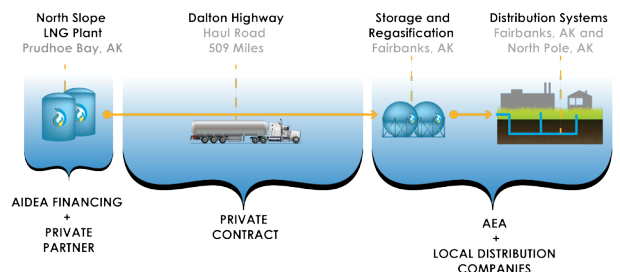
